POST-PRESIDENTIALLY DECLARED DISASTER GRANT PROGRAM

NON-DISASTER ANNUAL GRANTS

Flood Mitigation Assistance (FMA):

* 75% FEDERAL SHARE/25% NON-FEDERAL MATCH

To reduce flood damages for National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP)-participating communities.

Repetitive Flood Claim (RFC):

* 100% FEDERAL SHARE/NO NON-FEDERAL LOCAL MATCH REQUIRED

For residential or NON-residential properties that have received one or more NFIP payments.

Severe Repetitive Loss (SRL):

* 90% FEDERAL SHARE/10% NON-FEDERAL MATCH

For properties with:

- Four NFIP claim payments greater than or equal to \$5,000 each (any two claims at least within a 10-year period); OR
- Two separate claim payments (building only) with a cumulative amount exceeding the market value of the structure (any two claims at least within a 10-year period).

POST-PRESIDENTIALLY DECLARED DISASTER GRANT PROGRAM


Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP):

* 75% FEDERAL SHARE/25% NON-FEDERAL MATCH

The Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) provides grants to State and local governments after a major disaster declaration. HMGP was created to reduce the loss of life and property due to natural disasters and provides resources for the implementation of mitigation measures during recovery from a disaster. The State determines how projects are selected for funding and FEMA reviews for eligibility.

*Match requirements may change so check with your GOHSEP HM SAL for the most up-to-date information.
